The *Journal of Theory Construction & Testing* (JTCT) is a refereed research journal which is published bi-annually in April and October. The Editorial Review Board of JTCT consists of a group of professionals committed to the advancement of nursing knowledge, the development of nursing as a scientific discipline and the advancement of health promotion for all. Membership on the editorial board affords the individual an opportunity to participate in the evolution of JTCT as a vital literature source for health care professionals and others concerned with the advancement of knowledge.

The Editorial Review Board welcomes original research manuscripts which are submitted exclusively to JTCT. Authors should retain a complete copy of their manuscript for their files. Authors are encouraged to submit their manuscripts electronically. Although query letters are encouraged, they are not required. The review process normally takes about 12 weeks, though there are exceptions.

In accordance with the Copyright Act of 1976, enacted in 1978, the following statement should be attached and signed by the author(s):

The undersigned author(s) transfer(s) all copyright ownership of the manuscript (title of article) to Tucker Publications, Inc. in the event the work is published. The undersigned author(s) warrant(s) that the manuscript is original, is not under consideration by another journal, and has not been previously published.

All authors must sign this statement, in addition to signing the longer statement at the end of this section. Author(s) will be consulted, whenever possible, regarding re-publication of material. No reasonable request by the author for permission to reproduce any of his/her published contributions to JTCT will be refused. Authors of original and feature articles will receive one complimentary copy each of the journal in which their article appears. For this reason, addresses of each author must be included on the manuscript.

Manuscripts are reviewed by at least three members of the Editorial Review Board, who submit their recommendations for publication to the Editor. All submissions are subject to editing. Accepted manuscripts are submitted to the first author for approval and become the property of Tucker Publications, Incorporated. The first author is sent galley proofs, asked to proof read them for typographical errors and return them to the publisher within 48 hours. Important changes in data will be accepted, but authors will be charged for excessive alterations in proof.

FORMAT

1. Submit an electronic version of the manuscript which is double-spaced with 1-inch left margins. No less than 8 or more than 14 pages (excluding figures and tables) should be submitted. Include an abstract and key words for indexing.
2. Spell out acronyms the first time used in manuscript.
3. Indicate the placement of all tables, figures, and exhibits in text.
4. Use the reference style of the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (APA), 5th edition with the following exception: **Italicize titles of books, journals instead of underlining.**
5. Verify that references cited in the text match perfectly with those cited in the reference list.
6. Check quotations for accuracy of content and page numbers.
7. Submit a copy of a written permission letter if using previously published text, tables, figures or exhibits. Indicate to the editor the page number(s) in your manuscript to which the permission pertains.
8. Include your signed copyright release statement.
9. Include a completed manuscript submission form.
10. The cover sheet of the manuscript should include the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all authors including zip codes. Author identification should not appear elsewhere in the manuscript.
11. Drawings and illustrations should be submitted camera-ready.

SIDEBARS

A sidebar is a brief boxed segment of text that appears within an original article used to represent a case study or personal report of the author's experience that is directly related to the article. Format for sidebars follow those of a regular manuscript.

Manuscript submissions must include the following:

- Cover Letter including: article title; name, addresses (home and work), an email address and telephone numbers of all authors (home and work); disclosure of any commercial associations that might pose a conflict of interest or create a bias, e.g., honoraria, consultant arrangements, patent licensing arrangements, etc.
- Copyright release signed by all authors
- Title page with: article title; full name of each author with credentials, titles and institutional affiliation; all funding sources
- Abstract, no more than 200 words
- Key words for indexing purposes, up to six words
- Manuscript typed doublespaced, references, acknowledgements, tables, figures, illustrations, photographs
- Required permissions for tables, illustrations, graphs, photographs, hospital forms and protocols, etc. taken from another source

PHOTOGRAPHS

Photographs of identifiable persons, whether patients or staff, must be accompanied by signed releases, such as the following: "I hereby give (author's name) permission to use the photograph of (subject's name) in the *Journal of Theory Construction & Testing*." Please have this form dated and signed by the subject.

REPRINTS

Reprints are available to contributors when ordered in advance of publication. An order form showing the cost of reprints is sent with proofs. Readers wishing to obtain reprints of an article can do so by contacting the author at the address given in JTCT.
